***Kyoko Bartley Solo Exhibition to Open at Monroe Township Library Art Gallery***

**Monroe Township, NJ** — The Monroe Township Library Art Gallery is pleased to host a solo art exhibition by artist Kyoko Bartley, whose work will be on display from **November 1 through December 30, 2024**, at **4 Municipal Plaza, Monroe Twp., NJ 08831**. The exhibit is open to the public during the library's hours: **Mon–Thurs from 9:30 am to 9 pm, Fri from 9:30 am to 5 pm, and Sat–Sun from 10 am to 5 pm**.

Bartley's exhibition will feature over 70 pieces that she has carefully created throughout the year, exploring themes such as pet portraiture, Japanese aesthetics, hyper-realistic pencil portraits, and treasured scenes from New Jersey. The collection spans a variety of mediums, including watercolor, pastel, acrylic, pencil, and charcoal, reflecting Bartley's interest in capturing subtle details and natural beauty.

A special "Meet the Artist" will be held on **Saturday, December 14, from 2:00 to 5:00 pm**, where Bartley will be available to engage with visitors, answer questions, and discuss her work and techniques.

**About the Artist**

Originally from Japan, Kyoko Bartley has pursued her love of art from a young age. Self-taught and influenced by her artist mother, Bartley began accepting professional commissions while still in high school. Her studies in media opened opportunities to exhibit her work in both Japan and the United States. After moving to the U.S. in 2011, Bartley recently became a naturalized citizen and has since been recognized for her work in various forms, including painting, character art, photography, and sculpture. Her artistic style ranges across character design, hyper-realistic portraits, and traditional Japanese art, and she regularly collaborates with clients to produce commissioned pieces.

Bartley's work is frequently exhibited in local libraries and at community events throughout central New Jersey.
